Coming North on I-405: Take exit 17. Turn Right at the end of the ramp onto 116th Ave. NE. Turn LEFT onto NE 60th. St.. Turn RIGHT onto 132nd approx. ½ mile – Entrance is on the left. Watch for signs.

Coming South on I-405: Take exit 17. Turn Right at the end of the ramp onto NE 70th St. Turn Right at the light onto 116^{th} Ave. Turn LEFT onto NE 60^{th} . St. Turn RIGHT onto 132^{nd} approx. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile – Entrance is on the left.
