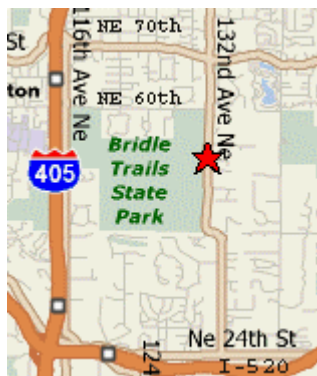

Coming North on I-405: Take exit 17. Turn Right at the end of the ramp onto 116th Ave. NE. Turn LEFT onto NE 60th St.. Turn RIGHT onto 132nd approx. ½ mile – Entrance is on the left. Watch for signs.

Coming South on I-405: Take exit 17. Turn Right at the end of the ramp onto NE 70th St. Turn Right at the light onto 116th Ave. Turn LEFT onto NE 60th St. Turn RIGHT onto 132nd approx. ½ mile – Entrance is on the left.
