



## **Kathryn Taylor Equestrian Park Work Party**

**When:** Saturday, March 20, 2010  
9:00am-1:00pm

**Where:** The Kathryn Taylor Park

Located east of Woodinville, north of Trilogy, just north of the Tolt Pipeline Trail with 232nd Ave NE and Fallbrook to the east, and 142nd Pl. to the north, and Lake of the Woods to the west.

**Why:** To cut down or pull up new small invasive Red Alder and Cottonwood saplings and Scotch Broom; trim back and dig out blackberry vines near the two main gates and other locations; rake round pen; rake zigzag trail up the mound; plant grass seed along dirt shoulder of the zigzag trail; and install wooden fences near bollard.

With all the huge governmental budget cuts and deficits, park maintenance is being reduced or eliminated in many parks. Continued volunteer support is critical to help maintain the park, just to keep it open.

**Who:** Everyone is welcome to come out and help, especially equestrians who use the facility. This is a great opportunity for students, Scouts, 4-Hers, etc., needing to complete volunteer hours. Even 1 or 2 hours of time will help. It's not necessary to stay entire time.

**What to bring:** Gloves, metal rakes, shovels, clippers, loppers or pruners. King County Parks will provide a truck load of additional tools and gloves in case they are needed. Bottled water and light snacks will be provided.
